








Parks & Natural Areas Levy

Neighborhood Park Development (\$5M) (2.5M for Bridle Trails Area)

Smaller-scale parks will be developed with amenities such as play equipment, open space, and trail connections. Proposed sites are along Lake Sammamish and in the Bridle Trail neighborhoods.



Bridle Trails Parks Levy Milestones


- 2008- Natural Parks Levy Passed by Bellevue Voters
- 2010- 2-Acre "Pashchinskiy" Acquisition Approved
- 2012- Bridle Trails Corner Park Plan approved by Parks
 Board and Council
- 2014- Bridle Trails Corner Park Construction Complete
- 2014- 1.65- Acre "Ginzberg" Acquisition Approved by Council
- 2015- 140th Ave NE Park Planning Begins







Bridle Trails Neighborhood






Ginzberg Acquisition Site - 4432 140th Ave NE







OPPORTUNITIES & CONSTRAINTS

- Adjacent wetland & wetland buffer
- Desirable park location
- Easily accessible off of 140th
- Wildlife Habitat and Viewing
- No current parking
- No sidewalk on eastside on 140th
- Approx. 1.25 acres of level open and potentially developable area
- Shared drive access



Work complete to date

- Site survey and wetland delineation
- House demolition project contract approved
- House demolition expected to be complete June


