We hope that you enjoy visiting Bellevue's parks. Here are a few pointers (laws actually) to ensure that you and others enjoy the visit. Please remember these laws are written to keep our parks safe for everyone. Thanks!

Please do not fly quadcopters/drones, or other unmanned aircraft in parks.

City of Bellevue Unmanned Aerial Vehicle Laws

3.43.300 Operation of motorized models prohibited.

It is unlawful for any person to operate any motorized model car, aircraft, rocket or watercraft in any park, except as authorized by the city manager or his or her designee. (Ord. 4480 § 19, 1993; Ord. 4071 § 1, 1989.)

- When you see any unmanned aircraft flying in parks, please call 425-452-7225 OR if you feel it is unsafe, call 9-1-1.
- Please note that the FAA now requires all unmanned aircraft weighing 250 grams or more to register with the FAA. See www.faa.gov/uas/registration for more information.
- Even when flying in legal areas, the FAA requires that you do not fly within 25 feet of people, vulnerable infrastructure or resources.
- Please follow all FAA "Know Before You Fly" guidelines at knowbeforeyoufly.org when flying unmanned aircraft in the City of Bellevue.
