

FARM BABIES INFORMATION

We bring young farm animals to Kelsey Creek Farm each spring with the intention of providing interaction and education opportunities for program participants and drop-in visitors.

Young farm animal viewing availability is dependent upon their health, the weather, and program use. When baby farm animals are outside for viewing they will be out between the hours of 9:30 am and 3:30 pm daily, the same as the older resident animals.

Farm babies will be available for up-close viewing and behind the scenes fun for registered groups scheduled with our Tour Guide. Interested parties can call Kelsey Creek Farm to schedule their tour date.

Note to program participants: While we do all within our powers to have barnyard babies available for our farm programs, due to circumstances outside our control, all of the baby animals may not always be available for program participants' viewing and/or interaction.

Note to visitors: The farm babies sometimes require special care and are not always available for public viewing during the first few weeks at the farm. We appreciate your understanding during these times and hope you will come back to see them in the near future.

For the 2019 Spring Season, we are currently scheduled to acquire the following barnyard babies for program use:

- Goat kids – due to arrive April 29, 2019
- Calf – arrived April 14, 2019
- Chicks – due to arrive April 26, 2019

While these animals will be arriving at the above times, they most likely will not be available for public viewing until the Sheep Shearing event and thereafter, depending on their physical health and disposition.
