The following projects will be funded and implemented by the Neighborhood Enhancement Program over the following three to five years.

NE-16 Ardmore Park Trail

\$110,000 **328 votes**

Ardmore Park

This project will provide a four-foot-wide, multi-use trail through Ardmore Park. The project will include two wayfinding trail bollards and a 40-foot-long pedestrian bridge over the stream. The trail will begin at the northeast corner of Ardmore Park, north of NE 26th Court, and travel southwest until intersecting with the existing trail. This project will bring an existing social trail into compliance with City of Bellevue trail standards, as well as incorporate reforestation and habitat enhancement opportunities for community volunteer participation.

NE-8 164th Avenue NE Landscaping

\$120,000 **327 Votes**

164th Avenue NE: Northup Way to NE 8th Street

This project will improve the appearance of the eastern side of 164th Avenue NE, between NE 8th Street and Northup Way, to support a more pleasant pedestrian experience. This project will provide landscaping in the existing grass ditch, between the street and the pathway, as well as in the grassy strip between the pathway and the fence line.

NE-1 Ardmore Park Playground Improvements

\$67,000 **324 votes**

Ardmore Park

This project includes toilet facilities, fencing and playground equipment modifications. The existing post and rail fencing around the playground will be replaced with new black vinyl chain link fencing. The open entry to the play area will be moved from the north side to east or west side of the playground. In addition, a new playground sandbox with “digger” equipment will be installed within the existing footprint of the playground area. The existing bouncers will be replaced with a teeter totter. The clubhouse will be replaced with a new rotating climber. These improvements will be added to the scope of a planned project to replace the playground equipment. Improvement to the toilet facilities will allow the portable toilet to be left onsite and serviced on a year-round basis.
